Hi

Thanks for looking into this and confirming that the tree was removed by ODS on the Council's behalf.

Although the tree was in the Osney Town Conservation Area, no prior notification of its removal was required by the Local Planning Authority here at City Council.

There are certain exceptions to The Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012 that require either permission to carry out work to tree with a Preservation Order or Notification of works to trees within a Conservation Area. In this instance, exception 15(1)(a)(iii) applies:

Trees in conservation areas – exceptions:

15.—(1) Section 211(13) (preservation of trees in conservation areas) shall not apply to—

(a) the cutting down, topping, lopping or uprooting of a tree—

(i) in the circumstances mentioned in regulation 14;

(ii) by, or on behalf of, the Forestry Commissioners on land placed at their disposal in pursuance of the Forestry Act 1967(14) or otherwise under their management or supervision; or

(iii) by, or on behalf of, a local planning authority;

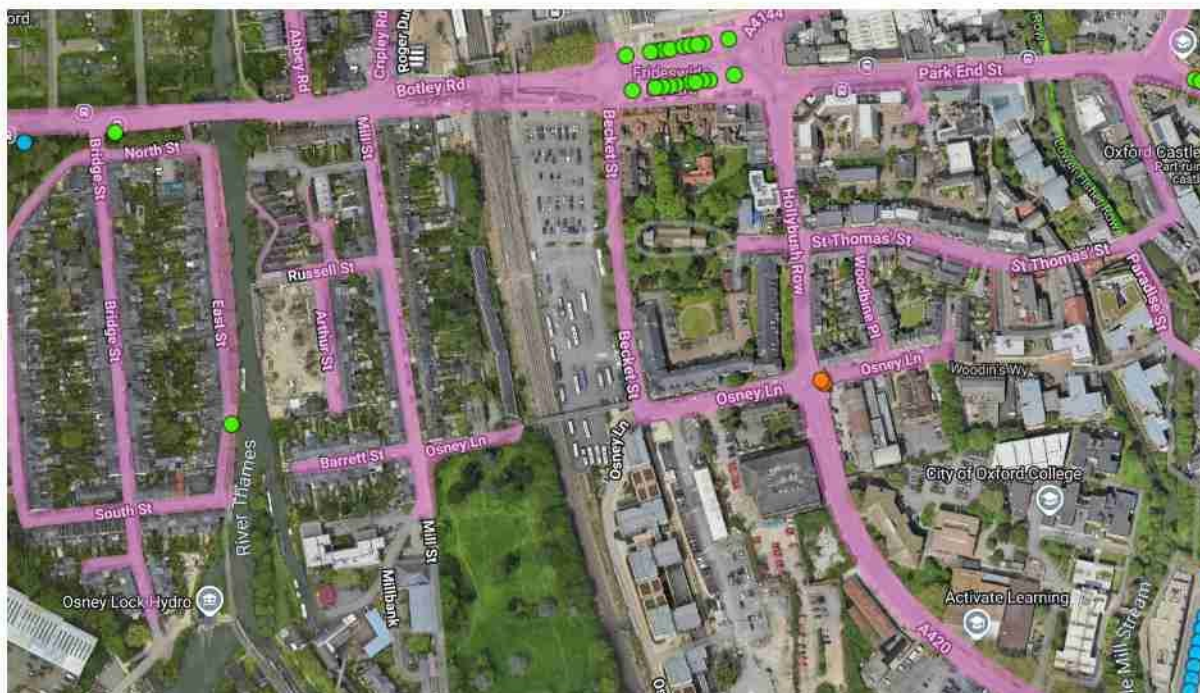
There is no record of a tree to be felled on our system in this location.

I have been working quite closely with O.D.S. and have not heard about this tree. They have emailed councillors informing them of the upcoming works in this years programmed works.

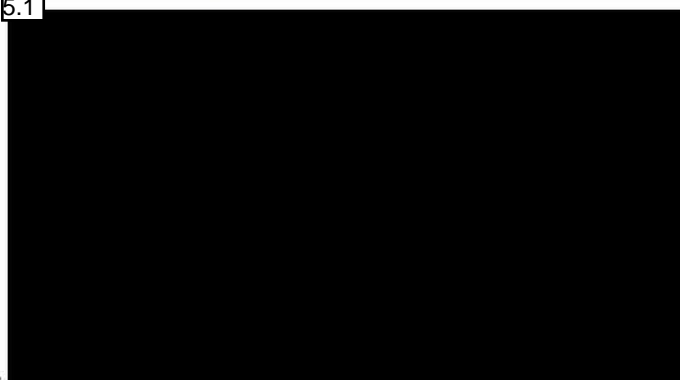

It is good to hear that the bike rail suggested by residents and turned down by the city and network fail years ago when the new solid sided gangway was installed is now suddenly possible.

But it raises a new concern I had walking that way this week. I have only just had the opportunity to notice that one of the fruit trees in the paved end of Osney Lane, outside Cherwell house has been cut down right to the ground. When did that happen? What is going on with that?

Not long ago 16.8 [REDACTED] wrote to us to ask where we would like MORE trees in our community, but now we have fewer! This spot in fact was one I wrote to 16.9 [REDACTED] to ask about increasing the number of trees.

When we moved into the neighbourhood there had been 4 cherry trees there. Then after the works to replace the footbridge with the graffiti-pissoir we were only allowed two. Now we have only one.

Let's restore four trees to that poor little amputated part of Osney Lane.
